2006 Cabernet Sauvignon Stags Leap District

This Cabernet Sauvignon from Liparita originates from a vineyard in the Stags Leap District. The vines are 15 years old trained on a bilateral system on a gentle slope.

Tasting Notes

2006 Liparita Stags Leap District Cabernet Sauvignon was produced from a small planting just off the Silverado Trail in the Stags Leap District. Red fruits dominate on the nose with aromas of Bing cherry, raspberry and hints of pomegranate. On the palate this wine's fine tannins are accentuated by firm acidity allowing the wine flavors to continue into its long finish. This Cabernet is very accessible early in its life.
